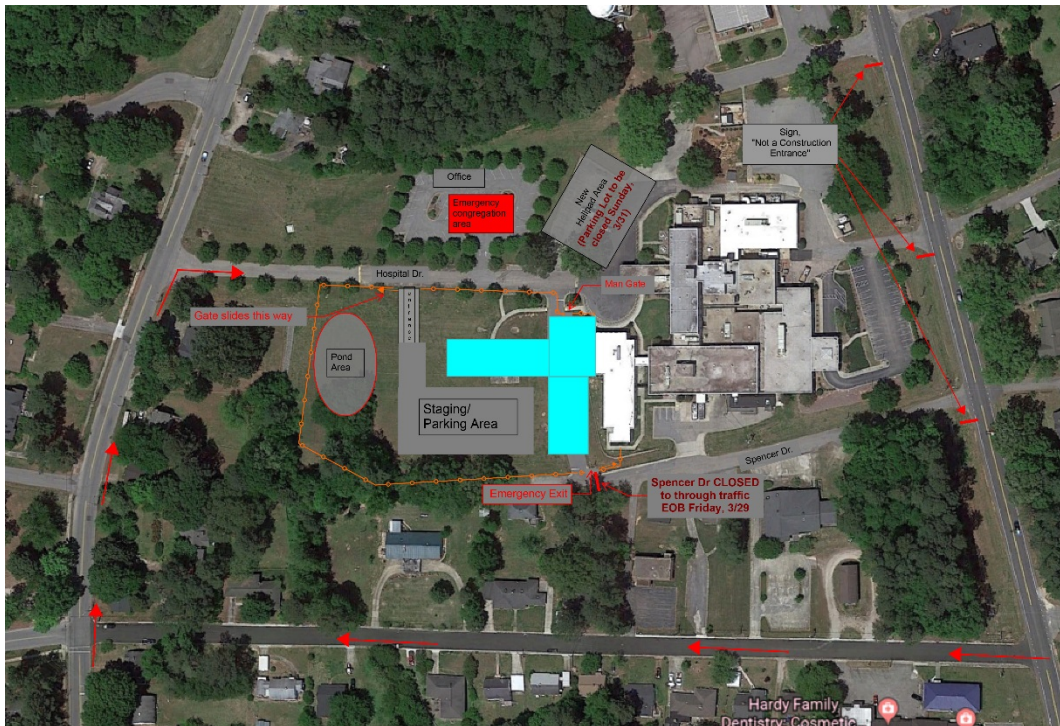

New Traffic Patterns at Maria Parham Franklin

Construction on new behavioral health unit will start soon.



Louisburg, N.C. (March 29, 2019) – Preparations for construction have started for expansion of the Maria Parham Health Franklin Behavioral Health services. This project will affect traffic and parking on the Maria Parham Franklin campus through the duration of the project. Spanning 14,900 square feet, the planned 20-bed adult behavioral health unit will adjoin the current 16 bed geriatric behavioral health unit at Maria Parham Franklin. The construction will impact several roads and parking areas including:

- The street behind Maria Parham Health that connects Spencer Street to Hospital Drive is closed.
- Parking behind the building closest to North Main Street in the rear of the building (previous main entrance) is closed.

- Hospital Drive around the building is one way from North Main Street to HWY 401/39.

There will be no impact to parking or entrance into the emergency room at Maria Parham Franklin. The helipad will remain open through the construction project for emergency transport. For ease of access through construction, patients visiting the Maria Parham Multispecialty Clinic should use the entrance to the medical office building from HWY 401/39.

Traffic patterns and parking may change throughout the construction of this expansion project. This project is expected to end February 2020. However, schedules are subject to change.
